





CHAIRS

Chairs should prioritize a design that resembles Brazilian culture, with arms and legs in natural or varnished wood.

Its backs and seats that resemble hammocks or wefts are also ideal for the project.

Chairs can also be made of plastic or acrylic, favoring colorful designs, especially if they are green or yellow. Chairs must be stackable, for easy transport, taking up the smallest possible space when stored.



STOOLS

The stools follow the same style as the chairs, prioritizing the woody details or materials in green and yellow, or white for better harmonization. Again, hammocks or wefts details make up well with the project.



TABLES

The tables in the lounges, meeting rooms and bistros tables must have feet in natural or varnished wood. The top can vary, being woody or white melamine. The service desks should be topped only in white melamine.







OTHERS

The rest of the furniture that is visible to the public (such as sideboards and cabinets) should prioritize details in light wood or in white, which may be a mixture of the two finishes.



Internal furniture can be standard office, metallic and with neutral or white finishes.



KITCHEN

The kitchen facilities must follow the industrial model, with stainless steel metallic furniture, easy to clean and maintain.
